

Customer Release Notes Fiery Integration Package 1.0

This document contains important information about Fiery Integration Package (FIP) v1.0. Be sure to provide this information to all users before proceeding with the installation.

About this release

Fiery Integration Package v1.0 includes Fiery JDF 1.3 and Fiery Integration Manager 1.0.

Fiery Integration Manager

Fiery Integration Manager is a tool that can connect to a Fiery Server and update its Fiery JDF version to 1.3. Fiery Integration Manager also enables an administrator to configure all of the functionality of the Fiery JDF installed on the Fiery Server. This allows the administrator to configure new Fiery JDF options without updating Configure with the new options.

Fiery Integration Manager is designed to help analysts prepare Fiery JDF for use. It is not intended for use by customers.

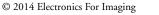
NOTE: For this release, Fiery Integration Manager is available in English only.

What's new in Fiery JDF?

Fiery JDF 1.3 includes new features and enhancements.

JDF control	Description
ImageQuality	JDF control of the Fiery image quality option
Brightness	JDF control of the Fiery brightness option
Pad Printing	JDF control of the Fiery pad printing option
Color Control Bar	JDF control of the Fiery color control bar option
Schedule Print	JDF control of the Fiery schedule printing option
Wire comb binding	JDF control of the Fiery wire comb binding option
SaddlePressing	JDF control of the Fiery saddle pressing feature, for printers that support this feature
BookletPressing	JDF control of the Fiery booklet pressing feature, for printers that support this feature

New JDF controls





Tracking of non-JDF jobs

ResubmitQueueEntry is a new JMF command that allows the details of a job to be updated without removing the job from the Fiery queue. This allows MIS systems to track status of and manage consumables of non-JDF jobs, such as those imported with Command WorkStation, submitted to a Hot Folder, or printed through the Fiery printer driver.

Banner page

With Digital StoreFront-to-Fiery Central integrations, you can create a banner page from the incoming job information.

Improved imposition

You can impose a JDF-submitted job based on Media, Trim, or Bleed box.

Improved DeviceCapabilities support

DeviceCapabilities returns only the options that are relevant to the finishers that are installed on the printer.

Tray levels

Tray levels have been added to the JMF media response (for Fiery Servers that support this feature).

System 8, Release 2 support

Fiery JDF 1.3 can be installed on select Fiery Servers that run System 8, Release 2 software.

Fiery JDF on Fiery Central

To install Fiery JDF on Fiery Central, Fiery Extended Applications Package (v4.2) with Fiery Integration Manager must be installed on the Fiery Central Server itself. This enables Fiery Integration Manager to install Fiery JDF on the Fiery Central Server. Installing Fiery JDF using Fiery Integration Manager on a remote client is not supported.

Dynamic option mapping

Dynamic option mapping between Fiery JDF and Fiery features is now enabled by default. However, dynamic option mapping between Fiery JDF and Fiery features is not supported for Fiery Central. The static mapping table must be patched to update the options.

Auto Device Capability

Auto Device Capability generation is not available for Fiery Central.

Linux installation

At this time, no Linux-based Fiery Servers are licensed for Fiery JDF installation.
