Digital Factory 11.3 Overview

This update includes a large amount of requested bug fixes, support for additional devices, and new core features such as the Gangsheet Wizard and the Express Color Wizard.

New Features and Devices

The highlights of the new features in this update are the Express Color Wizard and Gangsheet Wizard. The Express Color Wizard is designed to give new users a fast and simple method to generate great looking color profiles for their devices. The Gangsheet Wizard provides even more organization for your queues, allowing users to quickly group jobs for production orders.

- Introduced the Express Color Wizard.
- Added the ability to lock, export, and load settings.
- Added a Print to File toggle switch to the main workspace.
- Added printer support for the following devices:

Changes and Improvements

- Improved the interaction between the Variable Data Wizard and images with Contour Cut data.
- Users can now use negative X offset values when adding QR codes. This allows for more customization in QR code page placement.
- Visually improved the UI in the processing options window.
- Improved software tooltips and terminology.
- Added a Disable ICC check box to the ICC Profile page in the Edit Print Mode window.
- Added a Confidence Strips settings tab in the Queue Properties window.
- Improved the wording on warning messages to help clarify the errors that caused them.
- Updated the information displayed in the Product Information Window.
- Added missing translations.
- Added additional functionality to the Secabo DTF MultiCut Pro driver.

Fixes

- Fixed an issue where contour cut lines would not apply properly to non-transparent files.
- Fixed an issue where Costing Data would be saved regardless of the Record Cost Data checkbox status.
- Fixed an issue in which the Queue Background Image would not update immediately in Next-Gen UI.
- Fixed an issue where numerical control boxes would apply changes to the incorrect job when changing selection via mouse click.
- Fixed an issue where the Undo Plug-in Effect button would not work in Next-Gen UI.
- Fixed an issue where job notes would not print despite being enabled.
- Fixed an issue where queue job spacing properties would not apply when creating copies.

- Fixed a rare occurrence where printmodes would not properly sync when using Epson devices.
- Fixed an issue where camera settings in the Options menu would not save.
- Fixed an issue where QR codes would not display properly after using Export as PDF or Output PDF.
- Fixed an issue where Print to File would unintentionally switch to a NULL port when using an exported queue.
- Fixed an issue where installing a printer with no ICCs would prevent users from editing the ICC tab.
- Fixed an issue where the Manage Devices menu buttons would sometimes become unintentionally stretched.
- Fixed an issue where Job Costing numbers would be incorrect if a job was moved from the Reserve queue to the Active queue.
