The Anapurna M2540 FB can be configured as a four-color(CMYK) or six-color(CMYKcm) printer.

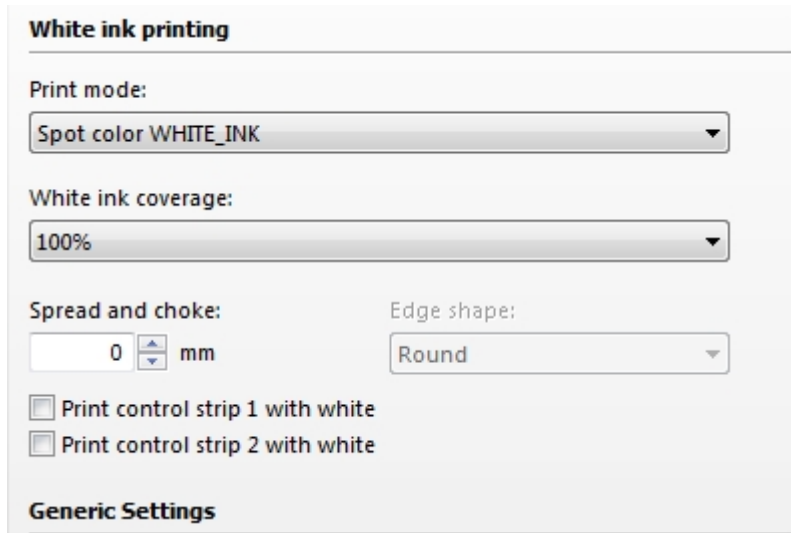
- Output settings
- The “Resolution” and “Print mode” settings are linked. Each time you select a different resolution, the list of possible print modes changes.

White printing

White adds another 100% of ink.

White ink settings

You can find the White ink settings on the Special Printer Settings pane for the output device (System Manager) or for the job (Job Explorer):
