Fixed issues

Fiery XF 9.0.2 related fixes

- Fiery XF server-related fixes:
 - Fixed an issue where enabling the FAST RIP option with the Adobe PDF Print Engine (APPE) could cause partial loss of file content after RIP processing.
 - Fixed an issue where jobs with special characters, like German umlauts, in the file name failed to arrive in Cut Server when sent as single jobs.
 - Fixed an issue where spot colors like White_ink or Pantone 281C were not detected when importing large PDF files.
 - Fixed an issue where importing small single-file separation TIFF files took several minutes.
 - Fixed an issue where cut paths were duplicated after upgrading to Fiery XF 9.0.
- Printer driver-related fixes:
 - Fixed an issue with EFI VUTEk GS series where upgrading from Fiery XF 9.0 to 9.0.1 caused printed colors to appear significantly darker.
 - Fixed an issue on EPSON SureColor SC-T7750, SC-P9550, and SC-P8550 where the Color Optimization (Pure Black) setting was not applied.
 - Fixed an issue on Roland DG VersaOBJECT MO-240 where an incorrect white ink print order appeared.
 - Fixed an issue on VUTEk GS3250 Pro where severe color inaccuracy causing oversaturated output occurred when using the Fiery XF 8.0.6 Support Package.
- JDF-related fixes:
 - Fixed an issue where JDF job submission would fail with suspended jobs after uninstalling Fiery Command WorkStation 7.2 from the same computer as the Fiery XF server.

- Fiery proServer and Fiery XF solutions are made from multiple software applications: a server application (Fiery XF server), a client application (Fiery Command WorkStation), plus color applications (Color Profiler Option and Color Verifier Option included within Fiery Color Profiler Suite).
