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Fiery Press Station Customer Release Notes

This document contains important information about Fiery Press Station releases. Be sure to provide this information to all users.

The Fiery Press Station application provides a streamlined and enhanced printing process. Press Station allows users with Administrator or Operator privileges to review and manage jobs submitted in Command WorkStation before printing.

In Press Station, you can connect to a Fiery server and then review the ready to print jobs from Command WorkStation in the Ready to Print queue. After ensuring the accuracy of a job, you can release the job to the Printing queue. The Status pane tracks the progress of a job as it prints. After a job is printed, it is released to the Printed queue, where you can review information about the job.

System requirements

To install the Fiery Press Station application, your Windows computer must meet the following minimum requirements.

Note: Press Station is only available on Windows client computers.

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Known Issues

Job columns in Fiery Press Station are the same for every queue

When job columns in Press Station are customized, the changes are reflected in every queue instead of only the selected queue.

Uninstalling Fiery Press Station also uninstalls Fiery ImageViewer

After installing Command WorkStation version 7.2 and Press Station, uninstalling Press Station will also remove ImageViewer from Command WorkStation. As a result, users will no longer be able to launch ImageViewer. To access Fiery ImageViewer, you must reinstall the Fiery Command WorkStation package.

Error messages are not shown in the Status pane

Error messages that are shown in the Job Status area of Command WorkStation do not appear in the Status pane of Press Station.

Fiery Press Station may ask for a system restart after updating

After updating Press Station, you may be prompted to restart your computer. You must then restart your computer before using Press Station.

Job groups are not supported in Fiery Press Station

Job groups are not currently supported in Press Station.

Fiery Press Station opens in full screen

Press Station will always open in full screen display by default.
